The Institute for Studies in Industrial Development (ISID) is a national level policy research institution under the framework of the Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR), Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India.

Applications are invited for Research Associates/Assistants for an ICSSR funded research programme on **Industrial, Trade and Investment Policies: Pathways to India's Industrialisation**. Major components of the research programme are: structure and growth performance of the manufacturing sector; trade, technology and FDI; industrial investment and finance; agglomerations, SEZ and state level policies; and participation of India in global production network.

The candidates should possess at least Master's degree in social science preferably in Economics, Geography and Sociology. Those who are pursuing M.Phil. and Ph.D. in the focus areas of research programme and who have handled unit level data (National Sample Survey (NSSO) and Annual Survey of Industries (ASI)) and remote sensing and spatial data will be given preference. It is essential that candidates should be familiar with statistical packages such as Stata for analysis of data.

Salary will be in the range of ₹20,000 to ₹25,000 per month, depending upon qualifications and experience. This appointment is initially for a period of six months, which can be extended up to one more year.
